Cuba Chamber Logo Updated

You may have noticed that our round Chamber logo has a new look. The Chamber's old logo was created in the 1980s and has served the Chamber well. However, times have changed and it was decided that our logo could use an update to better reflect today's Cuba. The new logo keeps many of the same elements as the original, but now also includes the Empire City Farms Block Barn, and elements representing the Cuba's cheese industry & Garlic Festival. The buildings on Main Street have also been updated, and an Amish buggy can be seen passing by. Cuba's "Liberty Pole" with Old Glory flying high, is now featured prominently in our logo, as well as in our community. As our old logo is phased-out, we hope that this new version will represent Cuba and the Chamber for many years to come.

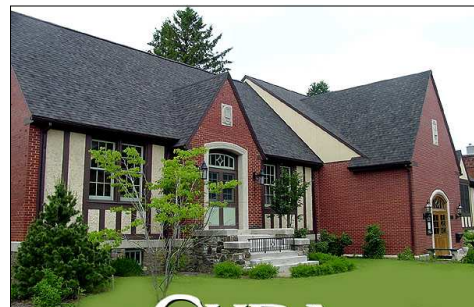
